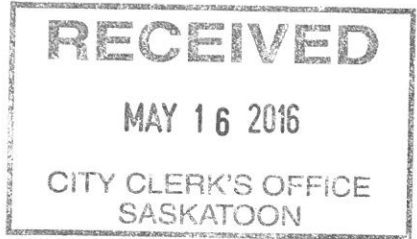

May 14, 2016 was the annual clean up date for the Hudson Bay Park/Mayfair/Kesley Woodlawn Community Association. This was the third year for this event where volunteers of all ages gathered to pick up garbage and other items in our neighbourhood parks. This year we cleaned three parks, A.H. Brown, Industrial Park, and Dr. J Valens Park.

As a volunteer and pet owner, I went through the A. H. Brown several times before this event to pick up pet wastes and broken glass so that other volunteers and especially the young children did not have to encounter this debris. I also do this throughout the year and leave a few "poo-bags" at the garbage cans. These bags appears to be used as I replace then weekly.

I humbly request that the Advisory Committee place smaller dispensers and bags in neighbourhood parks, especially those that have spray pool and or playgrounds. I would be willing to refill the dispenser at A.H. Brown Park until such time as the COS can coordinate a refill system with parks staff.

I would also note that Sum Theatre holds their "Theatre in the Park" throughout various parks in the City and A.H. Brown is one of the parks they utilize. These events are very well attended.
